



Monofilament net bags

As their name suggests, these net bags are woven or knitted from a single thread. Despite this woven monofilament net bags in particular are very strong and retain their shape well. They are commonly used for packing hard products such as nuts, shellfish and chestnuts. Knitted monofilament net

bags are softer and more supple and therefore more suitable for products such as bulbs and potatoes.

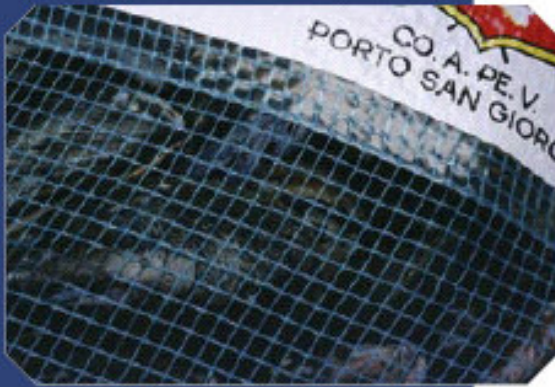
Type L-sewn net bags without drawstring in various sizes to suit the product to be packed and its weight.
